# The Rules!

1. You must introduce yourself and have a 15 second conversation about yourself or about quilting with each person **BEFORE** you ask them to sign one of the boxes. Things you can talk about are:
  - Favorite quilt technique
  - Favorite fabric designer
  - Favorite sewing machine
  - Anything quilty related
2. A person can only sign **ONE** time on **your** card.
3. Everyone can sign everybody's card!
4. When you have a Winning combination, Yell out **BINGO** and find the Prize Giver right away.
5. Winning Combinations
  - a. 5 Signatures in a Row (5 Prizes)
  - b. 2 Rows completed (3 Prizes)
  - c. 3 Rows completed (3 prizes)
  - d. Full Card (One Prize Only)
